State Helps Improve Village of Delta Water System

The village of Delta (Fulton County) will receive a grant to make improvements to its water system. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The village will receive a \$500,000 grant to install 6,581 linear feet of sewer line, two pump stations, 32 manholes, and construct an equalization basin to hold excess water during heavy rain. The project will benefit 1,497 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
